

VISITING NURSE | HOSPICE ATLANTA'S HEALTHY TRANSITIONS™ PROGRAM EXPANDS

Visiting Nurse | Hospice Atlanta is expanding its Healthy Transitions™ program with the addition of a Care Coordination Coach, Faye Fretz, RN. Faye joins the program after seven years in the nonprofit's Care Management division. She holds a Certificate in Gerontology, is a Certified Case Manager, and has devoted most of her career to helping older adults successfully age in place. Fretz attended nursing school in Toronto, Canada, and graduated from George Brown College in 1979.

Healthy Transitions™ helps older adults stay independent in their own homes, providing a continuum of care. Coaches work directly with the staff in senior living communities, helping residents who have had recent health changes. They assess participants for their ability to perform daily living activities such as cooking and bathing, and look at risk factors for health decline, such as falls. They also help them transition back to their own home if they have been hospitalized.
